

2007 RULE CHANGES

NEW CLASSES ADDED TO MINI MARATHON: Due to the decrease in circle race events, the NWSRA Board has voted to increase the amount of classes in the Mini Marathon events. The new classes are as follows:

- 17-25 Men
- 17-25 Women
- 26-39 Men
- 26-39 Women
- Junior Outboard (age 16 & under)
- Senior Outboard (age 17 & over)

All Mini Marathon rules apply to these new classes.

MINI MARATHON ELIGIBILITY CLARIFICATION: Please note: NWSRA Rules state "Skiers who have earned points during the current racing season in Heats A or B, may only ski in the mini marathons double-up with someone who has not skied in Heats A or B (with the exception of the 51-60 and 61 & Over Class). This rule will be strictly enforced and applies to all Mini Marathon classes including the Juniors.

HI-POINT AWARD ELIGIBILITY CHANGE: New rule to read: "In order to qualify for the year end Marathon Hi-point trophy, each participant shall have received points in no less than 50% of the points Marathon heat races in the same class". For example, if there are 10 marathon events in the season, you must receive points in 5 and be in the top 3 to qualify for a hi-point award. If there are 12 marathon events in the season, you must receive points in 6 and be in the top 3 to qualify for a hi-point award.
